



Dear Applicant:

Before you complete the application, make sure you meet the criteria listed below.

Criteria for Attending MCC or Baker College:

- Applicants must have a minimum CUMULATIVE 3.00 grade point average on a 4.00.
- Applicants must either reside in Muskegon County, attend a Muskegon County High School, be a graduate of a Muskegon County High School, or already be enrolled in Muskegon Community College or Baker College (Muskegon Campus).
- Applicants must plan to attend Muskegon Community College or Baker College as a first or second year FULL time student. The scholarship money must be used consecutively in the 1st and 2nd semester/quarter. The scholarship must be used beginning in the fall of 2017.
- Applicants must submit a completed and signed application form and an OFFICIAL school transcript along with an OFFICIAL transcript of any college credits postmarked by March 10, 2017.

Criteria for Enrolling in a Technical School:

- Applicants must have a minimum CUMULATIVE 2.5 grade point average on a 4.00 scale.
- Applicants must either reside in Muskegon County, attend a Muskegon County High School, be a graduate of a Muskegon County High School, or already be enrolled in Muskegon Community College or Baker College (Muskegon Campus).
- Applicants must plan to attend a technical school in Muskegon County.
- Applicants must submit a completed and signed application form and an OFFICIAL school transcript along with an OFFICIAL transcript of any college credits postmarked by March 10, 2017.

The Women's Division will invite a maximum of 40 applicants for personal interviews. Only applicants whose forms meet the above stated criteria would be considered for an interview. Multiple \$1000.00 scholarships will be awarded and may be used for tuition and/or books.
